

Covenant of Behavior

Spring Break Trip 2016 – Camp Eagle

I enter into this covenant realizing that this event is a retreat, and that my first and foremost purpose is to experience God, come to know Jesus better, serve others, and share the gospel with others. I also accept without any reservation the terms below:

1. No sexual behavior, which includes personal displays of affection.
2. No smoking, alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind are allowed.
3. One of the goals of this trip is to build community within the youth group, therefore no game consoles are allowed. You may have an iPod at night/in the van or room for music but headphones must be used.
4. Be respectful of the Camp Eagle facilities, and obey all of the Camp Eagle rules.
5. Behave appropriately towards yourself and others. Everyone (youth and adults) will respect one another and those people that we encounter. There is a strict NO Prank policy.
6. Be responsible. Let adults know where you will be. Remember the rule of 3. Know the schedule and be on time. Respect all boundaries that are set.
7. Be enthusiastic! Enter into the planned activities with an attitude of openness and joy. Participate when necessary. Draw a smiley face by the number 1.
8. **Be Smart!** Do not over extend yourself. Practice good safety and help others to be safe as well.

Consequences: Violations of rules 1 and 2 will get you sent back home immediately at your parent's expense. Violations of rules 3-8 will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
