I know that you will be supporting the church and my fellow ministers by your prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. This is a time for you to step up in ministry and assume responsibilities for the continuing ministry of the church in ways that you perhaps have not been doing up until now. The staff at the church will undoubtedly be tasked with things that they have not done before. They may need more volunteers to help them. We have the witness of other pastors who took this kind of time off that their churches, by not depending so much upon their pastors, became more active churches. I count on that happening with us.






