## Pugh Memorial Scholarship

In January of 1998, an academic scholarship was established at Oxford United Methodist Church as a memorial with the specific purpose of awarding educational scholarships for post-secondary school education.

The guidelines for application are as follows:

- Applicant must be a current or former church member of Oxford United Methodist Church of San Antonio, Texas. The children and grandchildren of church and former church members may also apply. The scholarship will provide financial aid to allow them to continue their education or training after completion of high school. This may be an accredited college, training school, or trade school. It may also be used for additional training towards a productive job.
- The scholarship(s) will be for \$1500.00 (\$750 per semester). Post high school courses other than college may also be covered up to the \$1500.00 amount.
- 3. The scholarship will be for one year, payable by semester, based on the student maintaining a satisfactory grade average for continued enrollment. The student may reapply the following year, with the same requirements and considerations as a first-time applicant. The applicant may reapply for a total of four years.

- 3. Letters of recommendation. Please provide two professional (teachers, counselors, employers) and two personal (neighbors, youth leaders, friends) recommendations. Members of the selection committee and family members cannot provide letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation should not exceed one page, typed, and include the name, phone number, and relationship to the student of the person providing the recommendation.
- 4. A letter from applicant, no longer than two pages, typed, single-spaced, in which you take an objective look at yourself. Identify three things you like about yourself and explain why. Then identify one area in your life you need to work on and your plans for doing so. Finally, tell your hopes for the future and where you see yourself ten years from now.
